Ford Airport adds “Mile-High City” to Nonstop Destinations

United Airlines launches service to Denver International beginning today

September 6, 2006 – United Airlines, which currently serves Chicago’s O’Hare International Airport from Gerald R. Ford International, today will expanded its service offerings by adding daily nonstop jet service to the airline’s hub at Denver International Airport. Passengers will be flown aboard a Canadair Regional Jet (CRJ) 700 aircraft, with six first-class, 28 economy-plus, and 32 economy-class seats. The service will be operated by SkyWest Airlines, a regional affiliate of United.
