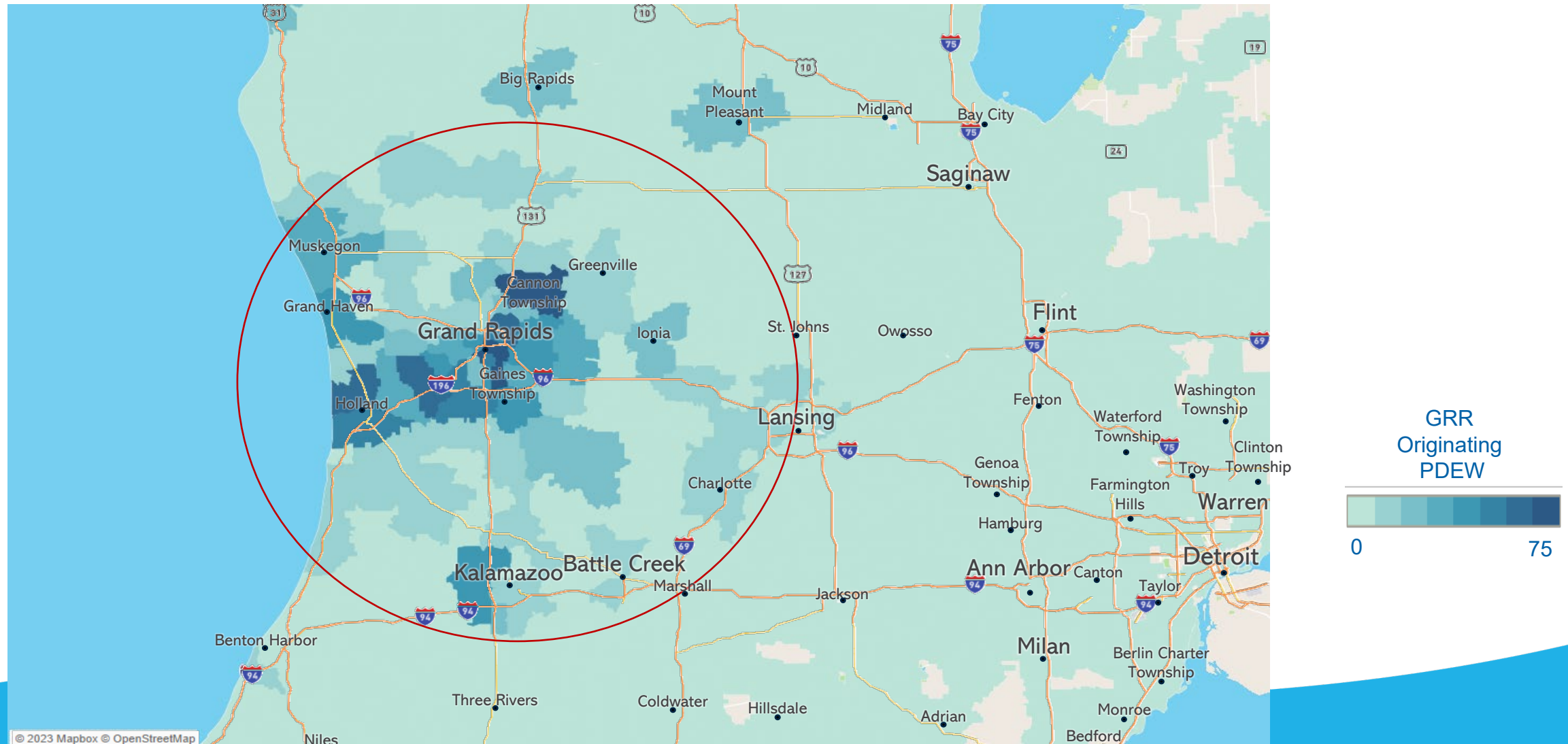

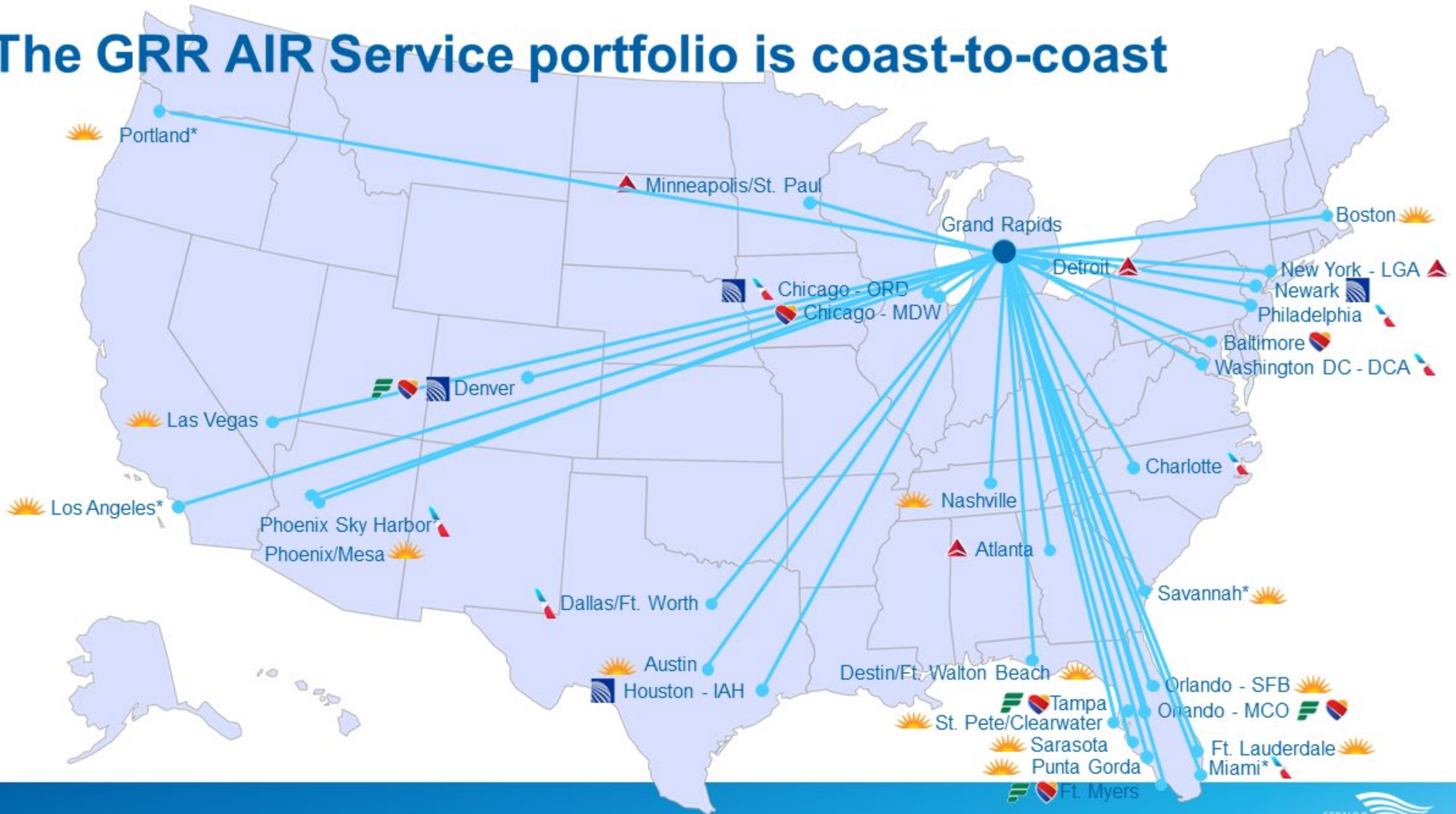

On-Call Airfield Lighting : RFQ Work Scope

Past and typical projects the Consultant team may be assigned include the following:

1. Assisting the Airport Authority in various investigations and report submittals, including determination of need, prioritization of projects, preliminary estimates, and a recommended schedule of completion.
2. Preparation of preliminary plans and estimates for various improvements in accordance with federal requirements.
3. Preparation of final plans and specifications, final cost estimates, and assistance with bidding various improvements.
4. Construction engineering services including inspection, contract administration, materials testing, and preparation of as-built drawings.
5. Providing ancillary services such as surveying, geotechnical, or materials testing. The Consultant may be asked to coordinate the acquisition of non-traditional services required by the Airport.
6. Assistance with identifying, securing, and fulfilling state and federal grant opportunities including AIP, BIL, and other federal and state funding sources.

Taxiway Lighting Assessments	2025-2029

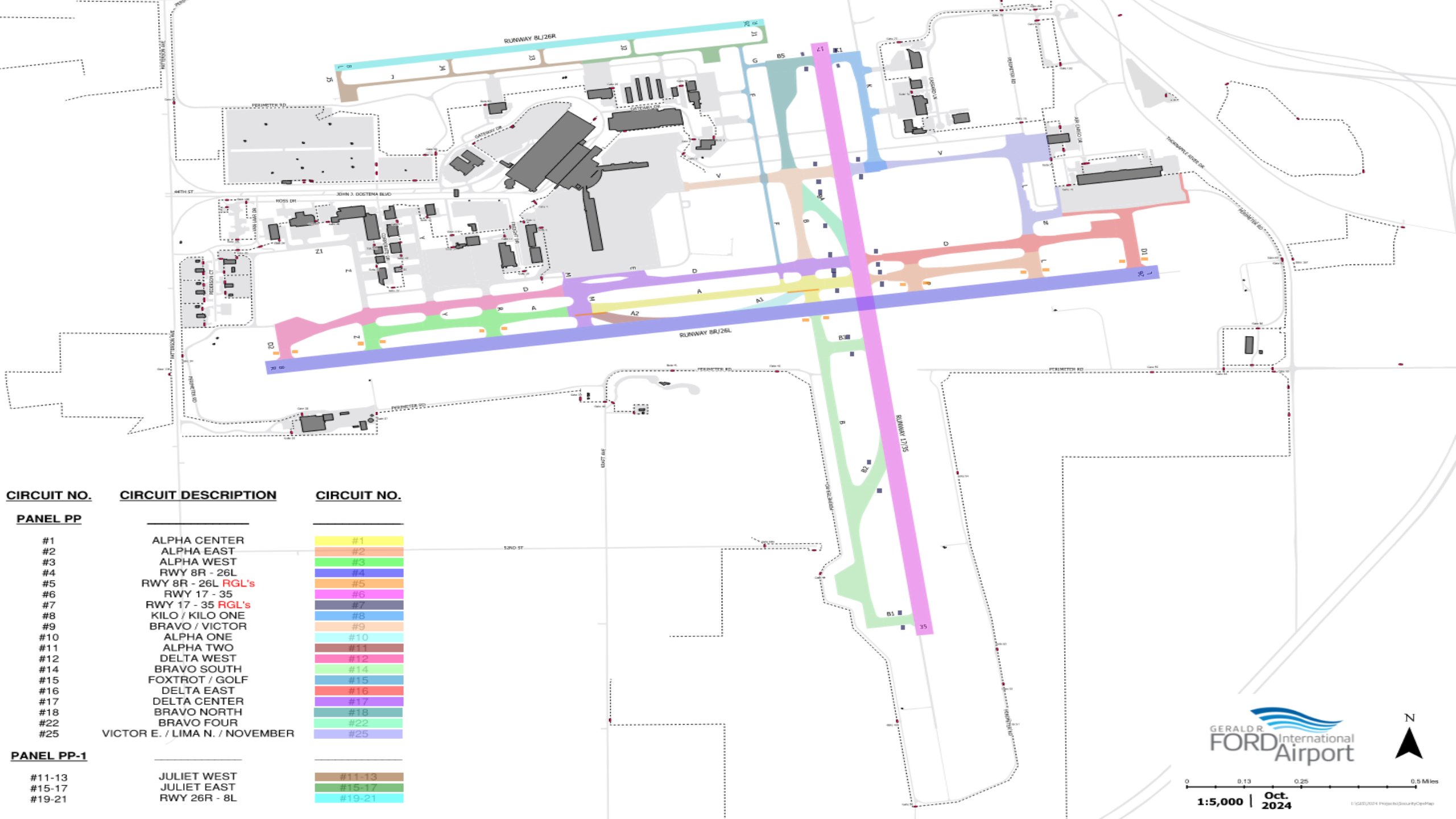

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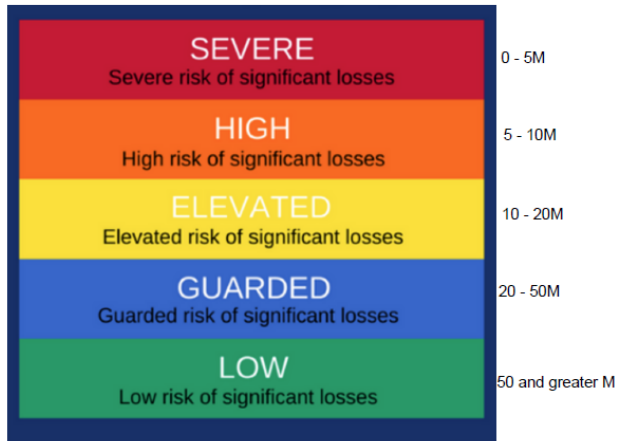

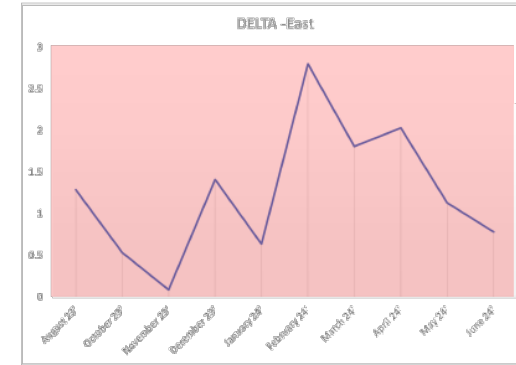
Taxiway Lighting Condition

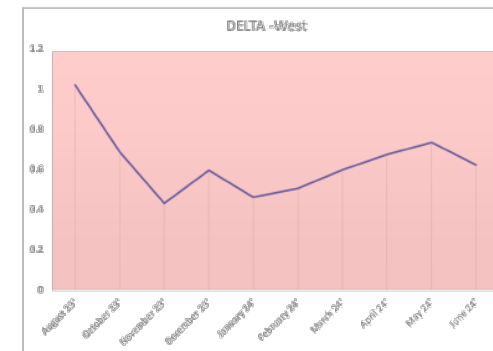
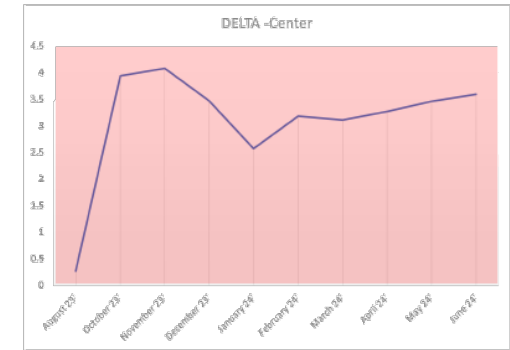
