### "LISTS OF ACCEPTABLE DOCUMENTS" - ADDENDUM

## A. For individuals who are not U.S. citizens, they may provide:

- 1. Alien Registration Number (ARN) Certificate + List B + List C document.
- 2. I-94 Arrival/Departure Form Number + List B + List C document.

## B. For individuals who hold a "Non-immigrant visa", they may provide:

1. Control number which appears at the top right hand corner of the visa and is labeled "Control Number

### C. For individuals who are U.S. citizens born abroad or Naturalized U.S. citizens, they must provide either:

- 1. Current U.S. Passport number or U.S. Passport Card number, or
- 2. "Certificate of Naturalization Number", Form N-550 or Form N570, or
- 3. "Certificate of U.S. Citizenship Number", Form N-560 or Form N-561, or
- 4. "Certification of Report of Birth", Form DS-1350, or
- 5. "Consular Report of Birth Abroad", Form FS-240, or
- 6. "Certification of Birth Abroad", Form FS-545, issued prior to 1990.
