- 1. Does the Airport Authority have a standard consulting services agreement we can review? If not, please verify that this RFQ will use the GRR standard Engineering Services Agreement.
 - a. Yes, this is available upon request at purchasing@grr.org.
- 2. Is there an anticipated time period of work that is anticipated for the scope of work?
 - a. This is a 5-year selection.
- 3. Are there any pursuits of certifications or energy performance benchmarks that are being pursued?
 - a. Yes, but may not be applicable for certain projects.
- 4. Are there any requirements related to minority participation, or does the hiring agency have this is as a priority?
 - a. There are no set requirements, however, minority participation is encouraged.
- 5. Would the Airport Authority consider lump sum payment terms for this contract? This approach offers mutual benefits, including cost certainty, simplified invoicing, and better overall value for the project(s).
 - a. No, GFIAA uses a Cost Plus not to Exceed model.
- 6. Would an award on this contract be viewed as a conflict of interest for future A/E design services contracts and preclude a firm selected for commissioning from pursuing design services?
 - a. No.
- 7. Is there a minimum participation percentage required for DBE, SBE, VBE, or MBE firms under this RFQ?
 - a. There are no set requirements, however, minority participation is encouraged.
- 8. Are front and back covers permitted in the submittal? If so, may images be included on them?
 - a. Yes.
- 9. May we include our company logo at the bottom of our response pages?
 - a. Yes.
- 10. Does the Owner require resumes for all proposed team members, or only for key personnel? Will they count toward the page limit?
 - a. You are free to determine which resumes are required for a responsible submission to be properly evaluated by our staff. For this section, the page limit is encouraged to be followed, but it does not disqualify any response.
- 11. Are tables, graphics, and images acceptable formats for presenting information in the response?
 - a. Yes
- 12. Are commissioning certificates for key personnel required as part of the RFQ submission? Will they count toward the page limit?
 - a. Please submit any supporting documents that you believe give the best representation of your submission.
- 13. What is the duration for the potential contract that would result from this solicitation? Are there any renewals? Is it open for negotiation?
 - a. This is a 5-year selection with no renewals. New RFQ published at the end of the 5 years.
- 14. Can you provide a list of systems that would be included in the Commissioning scope?
 - a. Scope will be defined on a per project basis and may include the following:
 - i. Mechanical/HVAC
 - 1. Heating, cooling, ventilation, and air handling systems
 - 2. Radiant heating
 - 3. Energy recovery systems
 - 4. Refrigeration systems
 - ii. Electrical



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- 1. Electrical power distribution
- 2. Lighting controls
- 3. Emergency and backup generators
- 4. Renewable energy
- iii. Plumbing and Water
 - 1. Plumbing systems
 - 2. Water distribution
 - 3. Sanitary systems
 - 4. Hot water and process water systems

 - 1. Building automation and control systems
 - 2. Life-safety systems, including fire alarms and smoke detectors

 - a. Low voltage commissioning should be included in the SOQ. The commissioning of specific airport systems will be negotiated on a project by project basis and may require the successful Commissioning Agent/Firm hiring a specialized firm.
- 16. Is Building Envelope Commissioning included as potential scope?
 - a. Yes.
- 17. Can the Airport provide a list of anticipated/upcoming projects or programs that will require Commissioning services under this contract?
 - a. Refer to the attached Capital Improvement Plan, some projects may not be applicable.
- 18. Please provide some insight to the types of Cx projects that are envisioned at GFIAA. Would these be airfield, landside? Heavy MEP systems? Equipment based, Baggage Handling, PBB? New or current construction projects?
 - a. Refer to the attached Capital Improvement Plan, some projects may not be applicable.
- 19. What is the anticipated duration for on-call contract?
 - a. This is a 5-year selection.
- 20. The RFQ mentions in Work Scope 1.f. ORAT participation and coordination. Does GFIAA have an ORAT consultant?
 - a. Yes, GFIAA has an ORAT consultant, as a sub-consultant, under the Airfield On-call Consulting contract and an internal ORAT Plan.
