


This briefing outlines key safety practices for all GRR badged (D or M) ground vehicle operators at Gerald R. Ford International Airport (GRR) when operating on the Perimeter Road and aprons. Adherence to these guidelines is crucial for maintaining a safe operating environment.

## Safety Practices

1. **Observe Posted Signs and Speed Limits:** Stop at stop signs. 20 mph on aprons, 15 mph within 50' of a building, 5 mph terminal building underpasses
2. **Give Way to Aircraft and Personnel**
3. **Maintain Situational Awareness:** Be vigilant of your surroundings, including aircraft, personnel, and other vehicles. Report any unusual activity immediately. **Know your route.**
